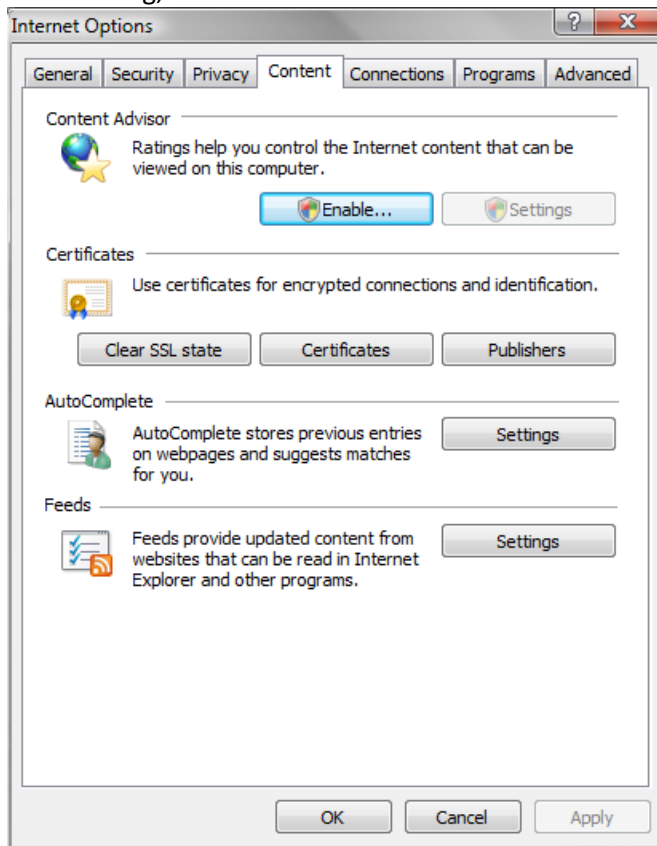


Instructions to turn on AutoComplete

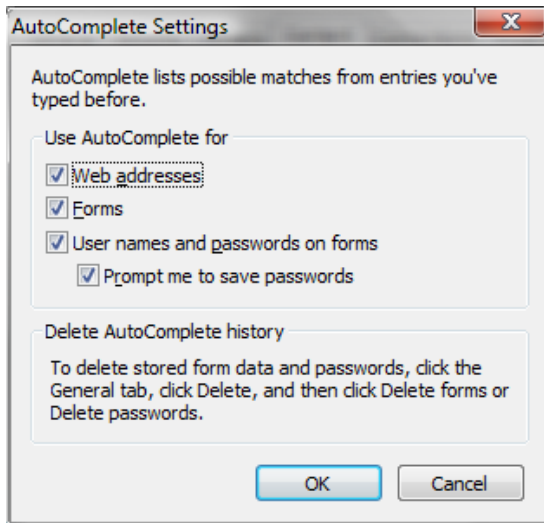
The AutoComplete in any browser will save data you enter in forms on a page and suggest them when you fill out the same forms in the future.

Internet Explorer

- 1) Go to Tools -> Internet Options
- 2) In the dialog, click on the "Content" tab to see the following image



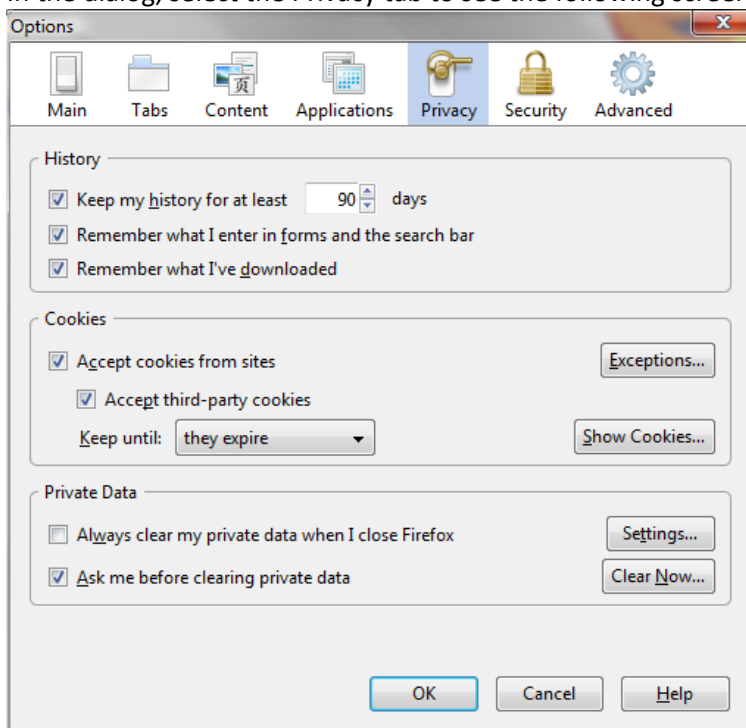
- 3) Under "AutoComplete" click the "Settings" button to see the following dialog



- 4) Make sure “Forms” is checked and click OK
- 5) Click OK in the Internet Options dialog to close it. Now data you enter in forms will be saved for future use.

Firefox

- 1) Go to Tools → Options
- 2) In the dialog, select the Privacy tab to see the following screen



- 3) Under the History section, make sure that “Remember what I enter in forms and the search bar” is checked
- 4) Click OK to close the dialog. Now data you enter in forms will be saved for future use.
